# REMEMBERING Soward

Howard Kenneth Mantle, age 86, of Jefferson City Mo., passed away on August 29, 2022, at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital.

He was born on August 27, 1936, in Linn, Mo., the son of Theron Orval and Wilma Olene Gaume Mantle. He was married on May 2, 1959, in Westphalia, Mo., to Ellen "Gay" (Allen) Mantle, who preceded him in death on August 1, 2012.

A lifelong resident of the Central Missouri area. Howard grew up near Linn and operated the family's dairy farm. He joined the Army where he was deployed to France as a wheeled vehicle mechanic.
