A resident of central Missouri her whole life, Bre attended Jefferson City Public Schools. She has been employed with Panera Bread for the last several years.

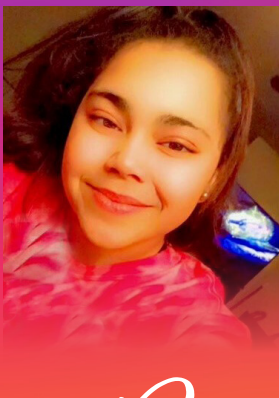
