Michael Dean Rummerfield, age 71, of Jefferson City, Mo. passed away Friday, May 26, 2023, at Oak Tree Villas surrounded by his loving family.

Witnessing his grandson's baptism this past week brought immense joy to his soul.

He appreciated watching any type of sporting event on the television with the volume as loud as he could get away with.
